Hall of Creativity Guidelines

All children will create their exhibit at school during the morning of **Friday 16th October**, ready for judging that afternoon. To avoid children being penalised please make sure they carefully follow the guidelines below.

Years 0 - 2: TIN CAN CREATION

Miss Mancer/Mrs Fergus/Mrs Morrison

- Using tin cans to create a pencil holder
- One 420g tin can (no sharp edges) with label removed, washed and cleaned inside and out
- 6 different items from home to glue on or add to tin can for decorating - eg tinsel, pipe cleaners, foam shapes etc.
- Can bring a picture for inspiration to help them put together their creation
- Cans will be painted at school during the week but need to be at school by Monday of the first week please.
- Hot glue guns to be monitored and used by adults on the day of creating.

Year 3 - 5: Paper Plate Animals

Mrs Hancock/Mrs Oliver

- Must be a recognised 'real' animal
- Size must not exceed 60cm in height or width
- Must use between 2 and 6 different craft materials (excluding paint, including cardboard)
- Plates, paint, cardboard and all craft materials will be provided at school.

Year 6 - 8: Upcycled Scarecrows

Mrs Kasupene/ Mrs Fuller

- Must be based on a storybook character
- Can be completed individually or in a group of up to 3 people
- Must be between 50cm - 1.5m tall and no more than 50cm wide from any point (excluding arm span and support)
- All materials must be recycled and all supplied from home
- Hot glue guns and drill will be supplied if needed
- Materials must be weather durable for a length of at least 6 months
- Preparation of materials will be done at school during the week
