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| Room 3 | Milk bottle creation    | <p><b>Equipment needed</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Must be a clean, washed 2L milk bottle</li> <li>* Craft materials to decorate ( up to 6 different items see yr 2 for examples)</li> <li>( Glue and paint will be provided)</li> </ul>                                                                                                                                                                                                                           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No preparation to be done before</li> <li>• Creation must be made at school.</li> <li>• Cutting &amp; painting will be done the day before at school, if needed.</li> <li>• Creation need to be no higher than 50 cm and no wider than 50cm</li> <li>• Can bring a picture for inspiration to help them put together their creation.</li> <li>• <b>Please note that nothing can be pre cut, drawn or stuck together at home. | 4      | Miniature Garden Scene  | <p><b>Equipment needed:</b></p> <p>Natural materials collected from home e.g. foliage, rocks, flowers, sticks, etc. Think carefully when choosing foliage, young growth will wilt.</p> <p><b>Optional Equipment-</b></p> <p>No more than 4 man-made items (e.g. Lego figures, plastic animals, craft materials etc.)</p> <p>School will supply the sand.</p>                                                                                                                            | <p>Using a standard sized roasting dish, students will create a miniature garden scene. This could be their favourite place, their favourite thing to do, farm life, etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Creation must be made at school.</li> <li>• Can bring a picture for inspiration to help them put together their creation.</li> <li>• No more than 4 man-made objects.</li> <li>• Creation will be contained within the tray.</li> <li>• No limit on natural objects/materials but sometimes less is best.</li> <li>• Meat tray will be supplied.</li> <li>• <b>This creation will be made in class on the day of the Hall of Creativity. Materials will be collected at home and brought in on the day.</b></li> </ul> |
| 5      | Wrapped Wire Sculptures | <p><b>Equipment Needed</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All wire will be provided.</li> <li>- Wood block for standing the sculpture on will be provided</li> </ul> <p><b>Optional Equipment</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- pliers (these are not essential but can make cutting easier) Some will be provided for sharing.</li> <li>- one very small object to enhance the meaning of the sculpture (Eg something in the hand of a person)</li> </ul> | <p>Using the crafting wire provided, students will create a sculpture of a living creature (human, plant or animal) that is no more than 15cm tall or wide.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the whole creation will be made at school</li> <li>• a picture can be used for inspiration</li> <li>• no more than 1 pre-made, man-made very small object per sculpture</li> <li>• creation must be self supporting</li> <li>• the creation must be no more than 15cm tall or wide (not including the wood block)</li> <li>• different coloured wires may be used (from the selection provided)</li> </ul>                                                                                                                           |
